BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

The Board, at the November meeting, was presented with the estimate for Stabilizing the Wall of Lamb Tavern Springhouse. The estimate submitted to us by Norman Glass is for \$2,100. The Board said that any estimate over \$1,000 had to have 3 estimates. We feel that this is a very fair amount, and don't know of anyone else to contact.

Indiantown Schoolhouse. When the company replaced the roof they recommended immediate repair to some of the stucco work on the Front Center Window and Roof. The estimate is for \$600, and they will likely go ahead with arranging for it. The Supervisors tabled it until the next morning meeting because they had more questions.

The Wallace Trust needs more volunteers. They are looking into replacing or removing some of the fencing around Lamb Tavern Preserve
