TOWNSHIP FINANCIAL AND BUDGETING

Chair D'Angelo, Supervisor Moore and Supervisor Seese discussed the import of robust financial controls and services to ensure that the Board and Manager can continue to guide the fiscal well-being of the Township budgets and accounts. With the increasing complexity of municipal accounting and budgeting requirements, the expanding role of Manager Randzin in other areas and the other with the time demands that it places on staff, the Board noted that it would like to explore engaging an independent, third party accounting firm to address the Township Treasurer services. Chair D'Angelo thus moved that the Township contact CPA firms to obtain quotes on assuming potential bookkeeping/Treasurer duties for Board consideration, with the goal of engaging those service at the start of 2021. Supervisor Moore seconded the motion, which, after further discussion, was approved unanimously.
