

Wallace Township Parks & Rec Board Meeting Minutes

Meeting Date: November 21, 2005

Meeting commenced at 7:40PM.

Attendees: Mark Bainbridge, Jim Lauckner, Jill Givler, Deb Schiller (WTPA).

Supervisor's Meeting Report – Jim attended the October Supervisor's meeting. There were no topics that pertained to the Parks & Rec. The bank who was the creditor for the developer of the Chalfont development that went bankrupt now owns those properties. The bank will be selling these properties. The Historical Commission will be having meetings about voting Glenmoore as an historical village.

Correspondences – GEYA filed a usage application for Indiantown Fields for the Spring, 2006. A decision will be made on whether these fields can be used during construction of the new school. We will hold off on approving the field usage application until that decision has been made.

2. Tree Lighting/Bonfire – this will be held on Sun, Dec 4th at the Twp Building, beginning at 7:00PM. Santa should be there around 7:30PM. Mark will provide a chair for Santa. Church group will be holding a bake sale. They will coordinate this with Kim.
3. 2006 Budget. We will resubmit a budget to redo the pavilion at Wagenseller Park, specifically the bathrooms. It is the opinion of the P&R Board that the main park of our Twp (which is right next to a sewage plant) should have permanent bathrooms. Ed (maintenance) has complained about the port-a-potties. It is

simply not sufficient for the usage the park gets. The board feels that something needs to be done as it will only get worse.

4. Jill Givler handed in her written resignation from the P&R Board. Jill will continue to be our liaison to DARC. Jill will also help recruit a replacement.
