Mark Eschbacher called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

**I. Approval of Minutes:** minutes of the February 21 minutes were approved.

**II. Old Business:**

Mark Eschbacher reported on the special meeting he attended called by the Municipal Authority on March 14 to discuss the Hankin well draw-down. In light of the information presented in the EAC draft letter to Federal and State agencies dated February 1, 2006 and presented to the BOS, the M.A. asked their engineer consultant, Craig Joss to provide a plan of action to resolve the issue. Craig intends to contact the requisite State and Federal agencies to discuss the issues raised in the letter. To keep the EAC in the loop, Mark will stay in contact with Craig Joss. It was suggested that a formal letter be written to the BOS detailing the course of action that developed from the M.A. meeting.

Mark Eschbacher reported on the PEC conference which he attended on March 11, 2006. Mark suggested that to make better use of limited resources, we reach out to neighboring EAC's to share ideas and efforts. He learned that matching grants are available through the DEP and the DCNR for stream restoration and educational brochures.

Mark reminded the EAC that Jean Ortiz would like to speak to the WT EAC.

Mary Ann Zeiders and Anna Marie Guglielmo reported on the Woodlands Ordinance Task Force progress. Maps of the WT woodlands have been prepared and the task force will begin to contact property owners to ask permission to inventory their property. Anna Marie presented stunning artwork featuring the bog turtle that will be used in the educational outreach campaign.

**III. New Business:**

- A. Community Day participation. The suggestion of having a booth at community day was well-received.
- B. UEB Stream Status. We discussed the potential future role of the EAC to work with other organizations working to elevate the status of the UEB to EV.
