

Wallace Township Parks & Rec Board Meeting Minutes

Supervisor's Meeting Report – Mark attended the March meeting. Mark reported that the Twp received one bid for the work on Alice Park. This bid was opened the amount was read aloud. It was determined that this bid would be submitted to Castle Valley Engineers for review. The amount of the bid (@ \$1.2 Mil) was well above the amount of the Alice Park grant (\$500K).

Correspondences – there had been an email sent to the P&R board about using some of the fields for cricket on the weekends. Mark responded to the individual to contact the Twp. Kim had not heard back from the person at this point.

New Business

Bathrooms at Wagenseller Park – Greg had a survey plan of Wagenseller Park. It shows a sewage line 69' from the end of the pavilion and a water line less than 30' away. The P&R board would like to put the bathrooms up against the end of the pavilion on the end near the snack shack.

Bryan had a portfolio from CXT Precast Products. They do prefabricated outdoor bathrooms. We liked some of their models. Mark will contact them to get some pricing and compare this with any results Jim may have come up with. We will discuss these at our next meeting.

1. Community Day – this will be held on Saturday, June 24th from 10 AM – 3 PM. The P&R board nor the Kim has not gotten any responses for Community Day Subcommittee volunteers. Jim and Mark will spearhead the organizing of

Community Day and will get on it now as time is running out. We discussed options such as contacting state and federal representatives for funding and participation. We will officially invite the other commissions, churches, fire dept, etc. and ask if they would like a table. Jim will stop by the Twp and get the contact info and all of the plans from last year's Community Day. We will contact DARC to participate. We will rent tents for the tables and use the pavilion for food/eating. Activities will be up on the field.

One main objective is to advertise for this event. We will discuss ways to do this.

2. Online Twp news mailing list – Mark contacted Ken Nicely about establishing an online mailing list to email residents newsletters as well as reminders of upcoming events. Ken said there is one but it is manual. We will persue this further.
3. Easter Egg Hunt – according to reports, the hunt went very well. The church did a fabulous job.
4. Basketball Courts at Wagenseller Park – the rims/backboards and posts are getting very worn and may become unsafe. Mark will ask Kim to contact Ed about these. If Ed can repair them to last the season then he will and we can budget for new ones for next year.
