

WALLACE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
June 9, 2009

A Special Meeting of the Wallace Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on Thursday, June 9, 2009 at 7:22 PM in the Township Building by Chairman Bryan McDonaugh.

Old Business

a. Wallace Township Community Day: Chairman McDonaugh announced that the Wallace Township Community Day has been scheduled for Saturday, June 27, 2009. The parade will start at 10:30 a.m., and the remainder of the events will run from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

b. Glenmoore's Got Talent Show: Chairman McDonaugh announced that the talent show application forms are available on the Township website or at the Township building. They must be submitted before June 15, 2009.

c. Valhalla Brandywine Partners Conditional Use Hearings: Chairman McDonaugh announced that a further hearing on the Valhalla Brandywine conditional use matter has been scheduled for June 9, 2009, at 7:30 p.m. at the Township building.

New Business

a. Gulick/Fairview Subdivision – Chairman McDonaugh noted that an extension request was received by the applicant for the Gulick/Fairview subdivision. Supervisor Moore moved that the Township grant the 90 day extension request, until September 25, 2009, for the review of the Gulick/Fairview subdivision. Chairman McDonaugh seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

b. Roof Bids for Indiantown School – Chairman McDonaugh noted that the Township has received bids for the repairs to Indiantown School roof. Solicitor Crotty opened and read the bids. Three (3) bids were received: 1) KPI2, Inc. for a lump sum price of \$24,000; 2) DiOttavio Construction for a lump sum price of \$36,200; and 3) Matthew E. Roberson Historic Preservation Services for a lump sum price of \$37,895. The Supervisors indicated that the Township would review all of the bids and would award the winning bid at the BOS meeting on July 2, 2009.

c. Cancellation of June 18, 2009 BOS Meeting – Supervisor Moore moved that the Township cancel the Board of Supervisors meeting on June 18, 2009. Chairman McDonaugh seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Public Comment

a. A resident inquired as to whether and when the Township website would be updated with the minutes. The Township Secretary was requested to look into the issue.
