- John Miller, representing the Village of Glenmoore Historic Preservation Group provided a brief history of the process, now underway, to have certain areas of the Village of Glenmoore designated on the National Historic Register as a Historic District.

The Wallace Township Board of Supervisors has provided a letter supporting this ten year effort by the Glenmoore Preservation Group and the application is currently at the state level (PHMC [Pennsylvania Historic and Museum Commission]) and is expected to be forwarded to the National Park Service and subsequently, if approved, to the National Historic Register for listing.
