3. Active Subdivisions--trail discussions with developers: none

  - a. Glen Dale Preserve
  - b. Highspire Estates Trail—Replace missing trail totem on outer trail. Trimming / clearing around Septic plant. Ask Steve Senn for help. Adjacent Wadsworth - Follow up w Barb D. (who would broach subject via Trust about crossing drive closer to road in lieu of current area to keep trail off Highspire Road).

  - d. Brandywine Hill

  - f. Municipal Authority - icons: Dorothy received approval at 5-19-2016 BOS mtg for bike, cross country ski icons to be added to trail posts, but not horses. BOS is reconsidering bike icon.
